JFY2024 Final Information Sharing Symposium

- Towards the Realization of the Proposed Initiatives -

Hiroshima University and Shimane University have been conducted a joint research project on how to improve the research environment for the female researchers at regional universities for two years between JFY2023 and JFY2024.

At this symposium, which will be held at the conclusion of the project, we will report on the status and issues in supporting female researchers at Hiroshima University and Shimane University and the findings of the survey and analysis of overseas good practices; and then will introduce the draft proposal consisting of the eight initiatives, which is the final product of this project.

After the presentation of the project taskforce, Prof. Eusebio Scornavacca of Arizona State University in the U.S., who has cooperated with us since the first year of the project, will provide advice on the initiatives of Japanese universities with focusing on the draft proposal.
